Resolution offered by House member Steven H. Richman:

Whereas, The NYSBA House of Delegates has been deeply moved by the tragic events two months ago at Stoneman Douglas High school in Parkland, Florida; and

Whereas, the young student leaders of that High School and throughout the nation have moved the issue of sensible gun safety to the forefront of the public debate; and

Whereas, good corporate citizens from car rental companies to banks have acted in support of that effort; and

Whereas, Federal Express declined to join those in supporting these efforts and continues to provide special discounts to members of a group that stands opposed to any and all reasonable, sensible and effective gun safety measures;

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the NYSBA House of Delegates that:

1. NYSBA immediately terminates it relationship with Federal Express;

2. The NYSBA officers shall take the necessary steps to publicly announce the action taken in # 1, above;

3. The NYSBA officers shall review all of the NYSBA corporate relationships and report back to the House at the June 2018 meeting, if any other such entities also provide any special benefits to groups that stand opposed to any and all reasonable, sensible and effective gun safety measures.
