 - ACT to amend the civil practice law and rules, in relation to insurance disclosures; and to amend a chapter of the laws of 2021 amending the civil practice law and rules relating to insurance disclosures, as proposed in legislative bills numbers S. 7052 and A. 8041, in relation to the effectiveness thereof. (Chapter Amendment to Comprehensive Insurance Disclosure Act of 2021)

 - ACT to amend the civil practice law and rules, in relation to the statute of limitations for civil actions

 such actions otherwise barred by the existing statute of limitations and granting trial preference to such
 actions; and to amend the judiciary law, in relation to directing the chief administrator of the courts to
 promulgate rules for the timely adjudication of certain revived actions. ("Adult Survivors Act")
